- Open to K-5th grade students in Brazos, Bellville, Columbus, Rice & Sealy School Districts.
- All artwork must be the student's original, individual, hand-done creation (no group projects or coloring sheets). You may not use images directly from the internet, magazines or other such media.
- All artwork must be 8.5" x 11" OR 9"x12" without a mat, frame or border. Acceptable art medium is crayon only.
- Artwork must not exceed 1/4 inch in total thickness and must be an original design and not a colored rendition of the attached horizontal artwork. The subject of your work must be the Attwater's Prairie-Chicken, its prairie habitat, or other coastal prairie species. - No lettering, signatures, or initials may appear on the front of the design. Any artwork with such identifying characteristics will be disqualified and eliminated from the competition.



Friends of Attwater Prairie Chicken Refuge Meet the Attwater's Prairie-Chicken

The Attwater Prairie Chicken National Wildlife Refuge, www.fws.gov/refuge/AttwaterPrairieChicken is located approximately 60 miles west of Houston, Texas, is one of the largest remnants of coastal prairie habitat remaining in southeast Texas and home to one of the last populations of the critically endangered Attwater's prairie chicken, a ground-dwelling grouse of the coastal prairie ecosystem. The refuge is one of a handful of national wildlife refuges managed specifically for an endangered species and was created to preserve prairie habitat specifically for the preservation of this unique species. The Attwater's Prairie Chicken is a unique subspecies of the Greater Prairie-Chicken (Tympanuchus cupido) a member of the Grouse Family. The Attwater's subspecies is found on the coastal Texas Prairies (now in danger of extinction), is smaller and darker (length = 17", wing-span 28") *. During the spring the Prairie Chickens can be found on an area of the prairie known as the leks. The males display by strutting and dancing (much like the plains Indians did) and filling their yellow-orange air sacks located on their necks. When expelling the air a low hooting sound much like blowing across a bottle, is heard known as "Booming."

The Friends of Attwater Prairie Chicken Refuge is a 501c3, nonprofit organization whose mission is to support the purpose and objectives of Attwater Prairie Chicken NWR and promote the recovery of the Attwater's prairie-chicken and the Texas native coastal prairie ecosystem for this and future generations.
